NEIGHBOURHOOD TRAFFIC CALMING – ‘SPEED HUMPS’**

**IMPORTANT NEWS – ‘PRESERVE OUR HUMPS’**

**To:** All residents on Post Road, The Bridle Path, Bridle Heath Gate, Park Lane Circle, High Point Road and Hyde Park Circle

**What is the issue?** The current speed humps that provide partial traffic calming are threatened to be removed based on an initiative of residential groups outside our neighbourhood. Final voting will take place on **November 15<sup>th</sup> at NYCC**. Approximately 30-area residents meet on September 8<sup>th</sup> at One Post Road to decide upon a firm action plan to preserve the neighbourhood ‘speed humps.’ There was overwhelming support for the preservation of the ‘speed humps.’

**What is the impact of ‘Speed Humps’ removal?** Increased traffic flow and speed, major streets can be re classified via the City making way for added traffic, potential harm to pedestrians, children/families using local streets and motorists due to increased traffic volume/speed, destruction of the neighborhood character – one of tranquility and exclusivity.

**When is the next meeting:** 5<sup>th</sup> October 2005 at Park Lane Public School, 60 Park Lane Circle, Gym, from 7 – 8 p.m. Parking at rear of the school.
