HOLD THIS DATE – Monday, 21st November, Edwards Gardens 7 – 9 p.m.

The Community Consultation Meeting with city staff, Councillors and Ratepayers Associations from Wards 25 and 34, and Allen J. Pinkerton, Manager, Transportation Services Division, Traffic Operations - North York District will be on Monday 21st November at Edwards Gardens, Floral Hall from 7 p.m. – 9 p.m. We encourage the highest resident turnout in order to demonstrate to respective Ratepayers Associations and to city staff the strong will of the Bridle Path community to maintain our vital traffic calming measures – ‘speed humps.’

On October 18th North York Community Council deferred consideration of the Speed Bump issue to its meeting of **Tuesday, January 17, 2006** when the Staff Report is finalized. The vote on ‘speed hump’ retention or removal will be therefore deferred to the January Council meeting.

Ratepayers Association

Preliminary work is underway to form a Ratepayers Association known as **Edwards Gardens Neighbourhood Ratepayers Association** for the community including geographical boundaries, executive, membership and functions.

Update on 2 Park Lane Circle

The OMB Hearing on 2 Park Lane Circle took place on October 14th 2005 with an impressive 10 neighbours revising their schedules to convey strong feelings for the retention of large lots in our neighbourhood. The Chair will produce a decision within a month.
