

## **NEWS ADVISORY - 'SPEED HUMPS' REMAIN IN BRIDLE PATH**

**At the City Council on January 31<sup>st</sup> 2006 Council adopted the vote in favour of retaining the traffic calming – 'Speed Humps' in our neighbourhood. The 'Speed Humps' on Post Road, The Bridle Path, Park Lane Circle and High Point will remain and status quo will prevail.**

### **Neighbourhood Update - Application for Re Zoning for Townhouses**

An application has been made for re zoning on 2425 & 2427 Bayview Avenue, to build 20 town homes situated between Post Road, and the Bridle Path. This represents a complete change to the entire housing stock in our community, not only for immediate neighbours but also to all of The Bridle Path. If the Official Plan can be challenged on Bayview, it may be replicated within our community, as our area is prime for intensification. An example is 2 Park Lane, this property was granted severance by OMB for a developer to divide the lot and build 2 houses. Let's not allow any further decisions!

This may set a trend, and eventually we will all be immediately affected! We must create a successful strategy for our community.
